The Certified Productivity Consultant Training Programme (with additional specialisation on Retail and Food Services), initiated by SPRING Singapore and supported by Singapore Workforce Development Agency, was launched in 2012. The Programme aims to train and equip consultants with the competencies necessary to support and facilitate the productivity upgrading efforts of companies in the retail and food services sectors.

In April 2014, SPC has partnered the Japan Productivity Center (JPC) to roll out the second run of the Certified Productivity Consultant's programme. A total of 52 participants had since graduated from the programme in 2014 and 2015. The fourth intake is slated to commence in April 2016.



SIMTech together with WDA offer the Graduate Diploma in Precision Mechatronics under the Singapore Workforce Skills Qualifications System for Precision Engineering (PE WSQ). This course is designed to train participants with capabilities of applying multidisciplinary and integrated approaches to design and develop high value-added industrial equipment and products such as semiconductor products, machine tools and robot manipulators. It covers the applications of robots for challenging processes automation. The course is conducted through a series of lectures, hands-on practical training and real industry cases by SIMTech experts with comprehensive industrial experiences.
