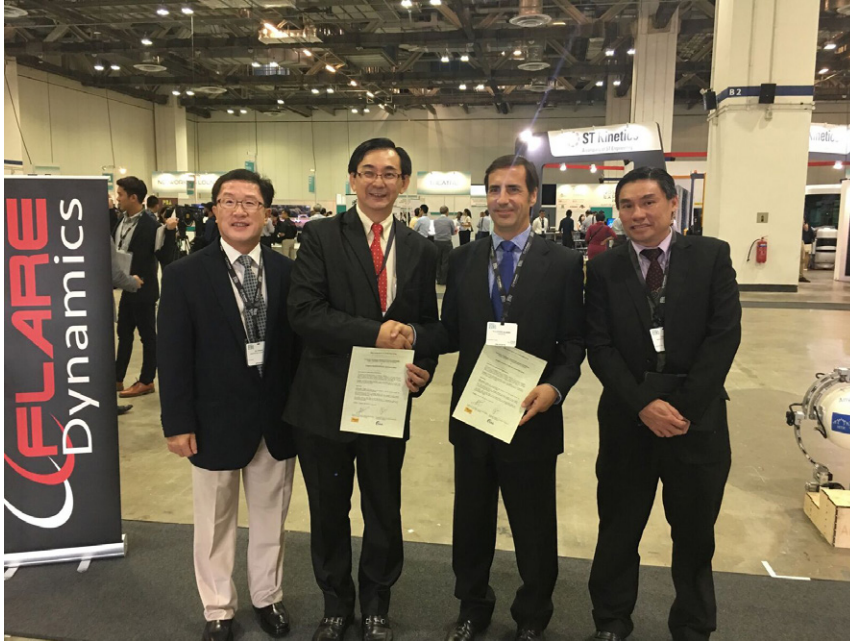

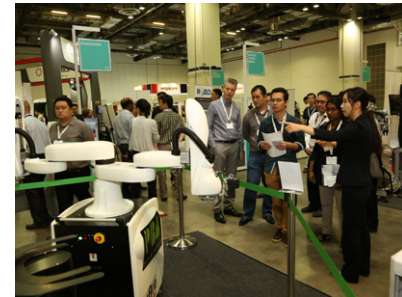
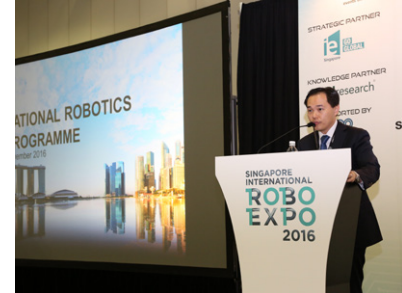

COMPETITIVE GRANT CALL FOR DIRECTED RESEARCH UNDER SEMBCORP-EMA ENERGY TECHNOLOGY PARTNERSHIP (SEETP) PHASE II

On behalf of the Energy Programme Office (EPO), EMA will be launching a grant call in partnership with Sembcorp on 8 Feb 2017. The grant call seeks to catalyse research and innovations that are industry-relevant in the following 2 areas:

- a. Domain A: Robotics and automation technologies to enable unmanned, autonomous, and remote inspection of service corridor pipelines in Jurong Island; and
- b. Domain B: Maximising the utilisation of low grade waste heat in a multi-utilities facility
